Member Policies and Procedures

(Effective August 4, 2020)

As a member of Elmhurst Golf & Country Club you agree and adhere to the policies below. Members are responsible for guest adherence and agreement to the same policies.

Failure to comply will result in the suspension of golf privileges.

The policies outlined below help us create a safe environment. We have assembled these policies and deem it necessary to meet the guidelines and recommendations from Provincial Health Authorities for the health and safety of our members, guest and their families along with staff and their families.

You are reminded that you visit Elmhurst at **your own risk**.

Physical distancing measures are expected to be intelligently used at all times while on property.

The following areas/services of the club will remain **closed** until further notice:

- Shoe cleaning
- Formal dining room (will be used as a lounge extension)

The following areas are **open**:

Administration Office – 9:00am to 5:00pm (Monday to Friday)

Pro Shop – 30 minutes prior to first tee time to dusk. **Hand sanitizer is present at the door and must be used before browsing merchandise.**

Prior to visiting Elmhurst:

All members and guests of Elmhurst Golf & Country Club must meet the minimum health requirements before being present at the club. This self-screening process is mandatory before every visit to the club. By going through this self-screening you agree to all policies set out by the club.

- If you or your guests are showing any signs of illness, you will remain at home.
- If you, or any member of your household has recently returned from travel outside of Canada or outside of the allowable areas as defined by the Government of Manitoba (**including government defined essential travel**), or you have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19, you and your household must remain self-quarantined for a minimum of 14 days.
- Before coughing or sneezing, please turn away from other people and cough or sneeze into your elbow.
- **Please adhere to recommended social distancing measures where possible.**
- Please be vigilant at all times ensuring you do not allow anyone impose upon your personal space while you respect the space of your fellow members and our staff.

Tee Times:

All members must complete the Elmhurst COVID-19 Declaration Form.

- **The golf course is operating at normal capacity for tee times.**
- **Normal member rules regarding groups apply.**
- **Members are responsible for guests following COVID-19 policies.**
- **Guests must check in at the Pro Shop with first name and last name for COVID-19 tracking purposes.**
- **Power carts:**
 - **Two riders per cart are allowed as of June 21, 2020**
- **Sanitized Pull carts & sand and seed bottles** will be available in front of the clubhouse. Pull carts are to be returned to the designated cart return area at the end of your round.

Club Services:

As noted above, these areas/services of the club will remain **closed** until further notice:

- Shoe cleaning
- Formal dining room (will be used as a lounge extension)

We would also like to note the following:

- **Retail Sales** - The Pro Shop is open as usual. Please use sanitizer before browsing merchandise.
- **Office Hours** – Open 9:00am to 5:00pm Monday to Friday.

Driving Range/Putting Green:

- The driving range and putting green are be open from 30 minutes prior to the first tee time until one hour before dusk.
 - Sanitized ball pyramids provided on the driving range.

On the Course:

- Bunker rakes and ball washers have been removed.
- Water fountains will not be in operation until government regulations allow.
- Flag sticks are not to be removed.
- “Pin Caddies” have been installed on all flag sticks.
Please use the handle with your putter to lift the ball from the hole.
- On-course washrooms are available, cleaned and sanitized throughout the day.
 - Sanitizing stations will be set up outside washrooms, please use accordingly.
 - Please maintain physical distancing where possible. This includes on the tee box, walking down fairways and on putting greens.

Upon Completion of the Round - Please leave your pull-carts and power-carts in the designated areas.

For staff safety please empty all trash into bins or take trash with you.

Food & Beverage:

- The Members Lounge will be open at maximum capacity allowable, with 2 meters between tables. Additional seating will be provided in the Dining Room and Colonello Room under the same restrictions.
- Reservations for groups of 12 or more will be accepted, in tables of a maximum of 10. Otherwise tables are available on a first come first serve basis.
- **When the patio is open: Smoking & Vaping is no longer permitted on the patio/balcony within 20 feet of any open entrance door.** If you would like to smoke or vape, please do so at the far south end of the second level. If there is an event in the Colonello Room there will be no smoking/vaping whatsoever on the 2nd floor.

General Reminders:

- Respect physical distancing and other policies for the safety and enjoyment of all.
- Club access is not permitted for members or guests who are in self isolation as a result of international or outside of the allowable areas as defined by the Government of Manitoba (14 days), or for anyone who has been exposed to a known or potential case of COVID-19 (14 days).
- **Do not come to the Club if you are sick or feeling unwell in any way. Respect your fellow members, our staff and everyone's families.**
