


Online Credential and License Program

Our **credential** program is designed to convert to college credits toward higher education degrees. Students who are enrolled in our credential program are building a college transcript that can be used to meet the educational requirements of professional degree programs. As an education partner with University of Phoenix, we can offer education and professional development programs targeted for Head Start professionals. University of Phoenix and HS University have aligned a curriculum designed to meet Head Start competency standards. Our credential programs have shaped assignments to real Head Start situations students encounter in their programs to help apply to their jobs and program quality.

HS University credentials build upon previously earned credentials thereby cost may be less than the costs listed, based upon the type of credential earned from other Universities or training programs. HS University uses Blackboard Learn for its online instructions. Blackboard is a Web-based learning management system (LMS) designed to support fully online courses or provide a space for face-to-face course supplementation.

We offer flexible scheduling with the option to attend classes from your desk at work, via online, or at a conference campus location near you. Student must submit timesheets to the University for confirmation of 120 clock hours of work in licensed field.



ERSEA Systems...

“Managing Compliance for Eligibility, Recruitment Selection, Enrollment and Attendance...”

The ERSEA Systems conference is designed to help Agencies ensure that their programs are implementing ERSEA requirements effectively. The conference will address potential challenges and give Head Start programs effective solutions to problems they face in implementing ERSEA. Students will leave this conference with proven implementation strategies and related support activities to help develop ERSEA procedures in their programs. When you complete the conference your program will have an action plan of how to recruit the greatest number of children, how to determine and select the most needy children and families, how to maintain their funded enrollment and monitor and manage attendance.



Eligibility, Recruitment, Selection, Enrollment & Attendance

What you'll learn and how you'll benefit...

The ERSEA Systems Conference covers subject matters related to ERSEA compliance. The ERSEA Conference is designed explicitly to meet regulatory requirements related to ERSEA compliance in Head Start. Below are the regulations covered in the ERSEA Management Systems Conference :

- **Eligibility**—Students will learn concrete requirements for verification of eligibility and enrollment of children and pregnant women according to Federal regulations
- **Recruitment**—Students will learn how to design recruitment events. Students will be given best practices for recruiting the neediest families within their community. Strategies for recruiting homeless, foster and disabilities students will be introduced.
- **Selection**—Students will learn how to prioritize families by using criteria based upon community assessment issues. Designing selection criteria will be explored and sample criteria plans will be shared and discussed for clarification.
- **Enrollment**—Students will learn how to develop policies and procedures to ensure program maintains funded enrollment and meets the 10% requirement for children with disabilities.
- **Attendance and Participation**—Students will learn what monitoring requirements are needed in order to monitor daily attendance and support families whose children are repeatedly absent.

These conferences will help staff understand ERSEA designs and management systems, understand staff roles and responsibilities, use tools such as community-wide strategic planning, PIR information and area plans to develop selection criteria. This conference will use team approach and breakout sessions to help management teams, policy members and administrative staff work together to ensure full enrollment, effective recruitment, developing selection criteria and completing ERSEA area self-assessments.



The Family Engagement conference is a strength-based, capacity building training which educates Head Start staff to create partnerships with families they assist by assigning responsibilities to both the worker and the family members there by relieving some of the burden of their job. The benefits of participating in this conference include new abilities to set boundaries with families and combat burnout; participants will have increased feelings of confidence to do their job; participants will have positive social support among co-workers when they attend the conference together; participants will have increased skills in communication with families, coworkers, supervisors and community partners.

This module uses several tools to assist you in helping the family identify goals. You will learn how to initiate family goal setting by building on information obtained in assessments.


Module 4—Remaining Professional

“Maintaining Comprehensive Health Services...”

Can training of health service workers advance a program's quality in these challenging and uncertain economic times? The answer is absolutely. The economic shift has caused a decrease in funding. No longer can a Head Start program focus only on meeting requirements. According to the 2007 Head Start Act, any program who lacks high quality comprehensive services will be required to re-compete for current grants. Any health service program that wants to be identified as a “program of excellence” needs staff that has obtained more than just academic skills. Quality service requires specialized knowledge and regulatory skills. This conference gives both. You learn regulations needed to determine compliance and knowledge that displays excellence!



Managing Comprehensive Health Services

This conference is designed to help programs support and enhance quality of health services by learning proper and consistent methods of delivering health services. It is based on the core principles and practices that comprise Head Start's approach to health care for children and families. It is designed to help staff recognize and implement policies, procedures and practices that promote comprehensive health services. The conference will cover information to help you learn new skills, information and federal regulations, and:

- Gain insight into current medical health, nutrition and dental health practices,
- Learn to monitor your classrooms for health safety
- Learn about medication administration, Short and Long term exclusion, Incomplete physical examinations
- Address barriers with providers
- Understand and effectively implement follow-up services for EPSDT schedules
- Monitor PIR health requirement
- Maintain up-to-date record-keeping processes
- Learn nutritional requirements as well as how to address food service challenges
- Learn techniques for working with families and children

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
