Information you need:

(*Check the list on the back too)

Collect ONLY Plastic Caps or Lids!

They must be CLEAN, with NO METAL or OTHER FOREIGN MATERIALS that are not plastic. Remove all foil and paper from the cap/lid.

Best Rule of Thumb:

It must be a clean cap or lid that is 100% plastic and not used for medical purposes.

Examples of Caps: Caps on Food Products: Bottles, Milk, Juice, Broth, "Squeezy" Caps, Peanut Butter, Mayonnaise, Ketchup, Mustard, & Other Condiments

Other Caps: Medicine Bottle Cap, Lotion, Soap, Toothpaste, Detergent Caps, Spray Paint, & Deodorant

Food Lids: Butter, Ice Cream, Dips, Cool Whip, Cottage Cheese, Sour Cream, Coffee, & Pringles

The NO-NO List:

NO Metal or Other Foreign Materials of any kind

NO Trigger Sprayers or Mechanical Pumps that may hide Metal Springs

NO Plastic Bottles or Containers

NO Dirty Caps or Lids

NO Foil or Paper Inside the Caps

NO Medical Supply Items - Except for Medicine Bottle Caps
