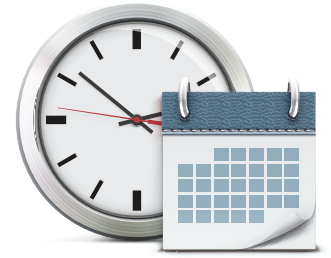


PRACTICE MANAGEMENT: TIP OF THE MONTH



Are your prescriptions pads compliant with the law?

CMA has received numerous calls in recent weeks from physicians whose prescriptions are being turned away by pharmacies for being non-compliant with state law. California law requires 14 elements that must appear on California security prescription forms, including “check boxes that shall be printed on the form so that the prescriber may indicate the number of refills ordered.” Security forms that lack the check boxes, even if they indicate refills in a different way, are non-compliant and are at risk of being rejected at the pharmacy.
