Mission of Service Project:

At the Project you will have the opportunity to explore your understanding of God's heart for others. You will physically offer hope and healing to a community in need, and you will daily be challenged to deepen your walk with Christ through a time of worship and reflection.

As an urban ministry, we are excited to share about God's heart for the city. Our hope is to broaden our youth's understanding of urban America and global missions, recognizing that over half the world's people live in cities (and that number is growing). We approach these ideas from a biblical perspective and believe they are important for the lives of teenagers everywhere.

At the Project, you will participate in one of three mission opportunities: Home Repair, Kids Camp (VBS), Mercy Ministry, or Church Partnership. Home repair consists of assisting in residents' homes that the Project has partnered with to help with tasks such as flooring, drywall repair, painting, etc. Kids Camp is like what we know as Vacation Bible School. Mercy Ministry consists of working at soup kitchens, shelters, food banks, serving the homeless in Philadelphia and more. Church Partnership groups will serve through construction work, prayer walks, distribute flyers about upcoming events, host community BBQs, help with children's ministry, or anything else that our church partners are hoping to accomplish.
