Your Pastor Nominating Committee At Work

Our Pastor Nominating Committee has been meeting for several weeks. At our first gathering, we selected Stephanie Hyatt as chair, Janis Williams as secretary, and James Lee and Stephanie to manage technology. Other members are Davis Carter, Heath Causey, Woodward Howard, and Barbara Rahrer. Our liaison with the Presbytery's Commission on Ministry is Carol Copeland. We will provide updates along the way and ask for your continued prayers.

Our first assignment was to prepare our Ministry Discernment Profile (MDP). This document provides prospective pastors with a clear and detailed picture of our church. That work is now finished, and the MDP has been reviewed by our Session. The next step is a review by the Presbytery's Commission on Ministry before we submit it to the Church Leadership Connection (CLC) for prospective pastors.

The next stage is interacting with candidates and discussing our observations and responses as a committee. We recognize that this process is not a sprint but a marathon.

Together we have worked to represent our church–its people, programs, and opportunities for service–in a way that will connect with our new pastor.

We ask for both your prayers and your patience as we continue.
