The 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Wine & Jazz Festival features wines of the Shenandoah Valley to sample and purchase. Additional beverages will be provided by Coor's Light and Blue Ridge Beverage. Entertainment will include live Jazz and Swing bands all afternoon. Festival hours are 1:00 to 7:00 pm.

Wineries participating include Barren Ridge Vineyards, Bluestone Vineyard, Brix & Columns Vineyard, CrossKeys Vineyards, Hunt's Vineyard, North Mountain Vineyard and Rockbridge Vineyard. They will be joined by a variety of food and craft vendors.



Tasting Tickets are \$20 in advance; \$25 at the gate (includes souvenir wine glass). There is no charge for general admission which includes access to the Music Pavilion, Artisan Fair, Food Court and Museum. Must be 21 to purchase Tasting Ticket which is required to sample wines. Present valid ID at the gate.
