INGLESIDE VINEYARDS

One of Virginia's oldest and largest wineries in a picturesque setting..

Located between the Potomac and Rappahannock rivers, Westmoreland County is Ingleside Vineyards, one of Virginia's largest wineries and some of the friendliest winemakers you'll meet. Originally a dairy farm for 50 years, this historic and picturesque estate, evolved into Ingleside Plantation Nurseries and later the Vineyards when it was discovered that conditions were prime for growing high-quality grapes. Ingleside Vineyards is a member of the Chesapeake Bay Wine Trail along with eight other wineries in the Northern Neck and Middle Peninsula.



The recipient of state and international awards for its wines, Ingleside Vineyards is a three-time winner of the Virginia Governor's Cup which goes to the top scoring wine in the Commonwealth. Also, the Bordeaux-style red blends, (*Left Bank 2014* and *Virginia Gold 2014*) won gold medals in the 2018 Competition. Ingleside was the first Virginia winery to bottle a varietal Petit Verdot, which has been named "Best Petit Verdot" at the prestigious San Francisco International Wine Competition.



Ingleside Vineyards produces some 20 different wines on 50 acres, with many of the wines only available at the winery. Visitors are welcomed for tastings, and they are

consistently voted by Virginia Wine Lovers as one of their top 10 Favorite Tasting Rooms.

In addition to a number of tasting options for individuals and groups, winery tours are available to learn how the wine gets from the vineyard to the glass. Picnics are welcomed in the beautiful courtyard or indoor pavilion. Visitors may bring their own or purchase gourmet cheeses and sausages in the Gift Shop, which includes two large rooms of wine accessories and decorative gift items. Groups of six or more for tastings should call in advance.



The winery is open every day from 10am to 5pm (Sundays 12-5pm) except New Years, Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas. Two waterfront homes are available for overnight stays, including The Pointe with views of the wildlife estuary and spectacular sunsets. The home is fully furnished and available for rental year-round.

Some upcoming events at Ingleside Vineyards include the Summer Music Series, which holds its closing event on September 1.
