ACCOLADES FOR BARBOURSVILLE

Robert Parker's *Wine Advocate* recently awarded 90+ Points to Barboursville's Nebbiolo Reserve 2014, 92 Points to Paxxito 2013, 90 Points to Octagon 2014 and Viognier Reserve 2015, and 89 Points to Cabernet Franc Reserve 2014, Petit Verdot Reserve 2014, and Vermentino Reserve 2015. Wow!

Alson, Chicago's *Beverage Testing Institute* returned ratings of 92 Points for Barboursville Octagon 2014 and 91 Points for Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve 2014, while *Wine Spectator* awarded 91 Points to Octagon 2012 and 90 Points to Cabernet Franc 2014.
