Grand Tastings will also feature Virginia distilled spirits which you can choose to taste and purchase. A first this year is an Oyster Bar with the best and freshest oysters in the country from Rappahannock Oyster Company. Meal-size food will be available for purchase from the food court.

The six days of Virginia Wine Expo include master-class seminars, wine pairing dinners, grand tastings, signature dinners and lunches. Thematic food and craft beverage events include artisan noodles and dumplings, global smoked cuisine, native Virginia cuisine, as well as Richmond's ethnic and culinary diversity.
