NARMADA WINERY TAKES BEST IN SHOW

Virginia's reputation and prestige as a producer of high quality wines continues to grow. On August 20, the Atlantic Seaboard Wine Association held its 13th Annual Wine Competition and voted Rappahannock County's Narmada Winery Cabernet Franc Reserve 2013 **Best Of Show**.

Virginia took more than half of the 73 Gold Medals, competing against ten states along the Atlantic seaboard. In all, 467 wines were entered this year. New York wines received 11 golds, with the remaining distributed among Connecticut, Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, and Vermont.
