Featuring wineries of the Shenandoah Valley, the lineup includes Barren Ridge, Bluestone, Brix and Columns. A variety of food will be available from Mashita, Big Red Barbeque, Paella Perfecta and Delicias Marina. Chrome-Tweed will perform from 5:00 to 6:30, followed by Randy Johnston 3 from 7:00 to 9:30. Festival hours are 5:00 to 10:00 pm.

Early bird tickets are on sale May 1: \$20 Tasting Ticket/\$8 Non-tasting Ticket (13 years old and up). Ticket prices increase June 21 to \$25 Tasting Ticket/\$10 Non-tasting Ticket.
