Virginia Cider Week is a celebration of hard cider and features special tastings, pairings, dinners, cider making classes, events and workshops.

Once the daily drink in early colonial America, cider was especially popular with presidents John Adams, George Washington and noted oenophile Thomas Jefferson. The Industrial Revolution and changing tastes that preferred beer led to a decline in fermented cider production and consumption, and prohibition dealt a final blow to many orchards.

The cider scene in Virginia has exploded over the past few years, and there are now more than 20 operating cideries. They continue to make innovative beverages that honor the state's rich history while looking to new trends, tastes, and styles.
