

TRI-CHAMBER Small Business Stabilization Grant (Applicants)

The Tri-Chambers understand the challenges that many small businesses currently face. As an integral part of our community we want to support small businesses financially impacted by closures or restrictions related to COVID-19. For businesses that meet the proper requirements below, we have developed a business support grant using federal CARES ACT Funds.

Grant Award: up to \$25,000 5-20 employees
up to \$10,000 1-4 employees

Grant Uses: Working Capital (rent, utilities, inventory, payroll, license fees, etc.)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must have 20 or less full-time employees as of March 15, 2020
 - (sole proprietor and home-based business are eligible)
- Must have an active business license in Clark County
- Must have been in business for at least 6-months prior to March 15, 2020
- Must have an actual financial hardship (financial statements from previous 6 months will be reviewed) Profit & Loss Statement will be accepted
- Must not have any federal, state or county tax liens
- The funds can only be used for businesses within unincorporated Clark County.

Non-eligible Businesses:

- Adult Oriented Businesses
- Cannabis Related Businesses
- Massage Parlors
- Liquor Stores
- Bail Bonds
- Check Cashing Facilities
- Payday Loan and other Short-Term Loan Operators
- Non-profit Organizations
- State & Federal Certified Labor Unions
- The funds can only be used for businesses within unincorporated Clark County.

- List of potential uses including but not limited to payroll, rent, inventory, etc...

- Hardship Statement: (including 2020 financials Profit & Loss Statement will be accepted):
 - Summary of business operations prior to COVID-19 and what has happened since, including 2020 financials
- 2019 Business Financial statements
 - Profit & Loss and/or Balance Sheet statements or 2019 Tax Return if completed
- 2018 Business Tax Returns (or Schedule C in Personal Tax Return)
- Current Debt schedule
- W-9 Request for taxpayer Identification Number and Certification
- Copy of active business license(s)
- Copy of partnership Agreement, if applicable
- Copy of Articles of Incorporation, if applicable
