

Principal, staff, teachers and parents:

Per our conversation with the school recently, I am sending you some more details to familiarize you with what we have done the previous years. We held two San Pedro competitions in 2013 and 2014 and a harbor-wide competition in 2015 through 2020.

The videos are about the receptions so it features the kids, friends and family as well as the artwork.

The competition is available to all students from TK to high school.

The media accepted is 2D (drawings, paintings, photography) and should be in the following standardized sizes (unmatted and unframed) up to 11x 15 for drawings, paintings and mixed media, 8 x 10 and 11 x 14 for photography and 11 x 14 and 16 x 20 for canvas and canvas board.

Video submissions should be under 3minutes.

A panel of art professionals will juror the show.

No restriction on subject matter. The appropriateness of the subject matter will be up to the discretion of the jurors.

Students whose artwork is accepted will be eligible for cash prizes for 1st 2nd, 3rd and Honorable Mention at all three grade levels (Elementary, Middle and High School) and will receive art supplies, ribbons, student membership in SPAA. Students selected for the top four awards in each grade category have their art work framed and have a three month exhibition of their framed art at Crafted at the Port of Los Angeles.

The deadline for pick up of artwork at the school will be June 21st. Artwork will need to be in the main office by June 18th. Artwork submitted on line will need to be sent by June 21st and sent to spaa@sanpedroart.org

An email with all the rules and submission requirements as well as parental permission forms and entry labels will start being sent this month (March).

We don't want to crowd a teacher's curriculum, so we encourage the kids to do this project on their own time whether at school (if available) or at home.

This is a great opportunity to recognize, reward and encourage the kids' artistic talents.

We hope you all encourage the students' participation in this year's competition.
