WHAT IS A C.S.A.?

C.S.A. stands for **Community Supported Agriculture**. It is a creative agricultural business model in which farmers sell shares in their harvest directly to local customers before the growing season begins. Folks who purchase those shares are known as C.S.A. members.

Once per week during the growing season, C.S.A. members visit Pakeen Farm in Canton, Massachusetts to pick up their share of the week's harvest. The size of the share varies with the pace of the harvest, averaging roughly one shopping bag full of fresh produce per week.
