



CO 121 (WADSWORTH) RESURFACING

During the week of March 18, construction activities will begin on a Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) repaving project on Colorado Highway 121 (Wadsworth Boulevard) between 4th Avenue and Yale Avenue in Lakewood. The project will improve the safety and operation of the roadway by installing or repairing 91 ADA ramps and by replacing approximately 26,000 tons of asphalt on the 3.7 miles of roadway.

Martin Marietta of Westminster, CO is the contractor for this \$5.2 million dollar project, which is funded by State and Federal dollars.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The project includes the removal and replacement of asphalt paving, adding concrete curb ramps, installing concrete raised islands, and replacing traffic signal controls for pedestrians.


Crews will install nine new ADA compliant curb ramps and upgrade 82 existing curb ramps. 19 pedestrian signal push-button poles will also be upgraded to improve pedestrian access to the controls. The asphalt repaving will eliminate potholes and deep grooves in the roadway, reducing the risk of damage to vehicles and providing a smoother ride for drivers.

SCHEDULE AND WORKING HOURS

The project will begin in mid-March and is scheduled for completion in October of 2019.

During the first phase of the project crews will upgrade and install the concrete ADA curb ramps along Wadsworth Boulevard. The asphalt work will begin in the spring.

Normal daytime working hours will vary depending on the location of the work. Monday through Friday, northbound single lane closures are possible from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m. and southbound single lane closures are permitted between 7 a.m. and 3 p.m. Nighttime work hours will begin in the spring. Normal nighttime work hours will be Sunday through Thursday nights, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

During daytime work hours, intermittent turn lane and single lane closures can be expected on Wadsworth Boulevard in both directions. Sidewalk closures may be in place for up to three continuous days to allow for curing of concrete at intersections.

BUS STOP & PEDESTRIAN IMPACTS

During the ADA ramp upgrades, pedestrians will experience detours around the impacted intersection corners. At least two corners of the intersection will remain usable. Please plan additional time to follow the detours around the closures.

Some RTD bus stops may be impacted during construction. The construction crews will work with RTD to provide temporary pedestrian access to bus stops within project limits.
