CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

(16 CREDIT HOURS)

»» Intro to Nonprofit Organizations (3cr.)

Explores the evolution and role of the nonprofit sector in society and provides an understanding of, and practical experience with, the key issues and challenges facing nonprofit organizations.

»» Program Design & Evaluation (3cr.)

Introduces the analytical, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills required for program design, evaluation, and data-driven decision-making.

»» Building Support for Nonprofits (3cr.)

Introduces the many ways nonprofits earn revenue to support their programs and activities from private and public grant opportunities, donations from individuals and corporations, local and national foundation support, and social enterprise.

»» Nonprofit Financial Management (3cr.)

Explores the key elements of financial management for nonprofit organizations including financial planning and budgeting, management of cash flows, short- and long-term financing, and endowment management policies and practices.

»» Conflict Resolution or Elective (1cr.)

Focuses on handling conflict productively. Students gain insights into the roots of conflict and engage in skill practice in mediating interpersonal conflicts. Other electives may be substituted, if approved by faculty.

»» Internship or Project (3cr.)

Provides a hands-on field experience where students can apply their program coursework, deepen their learning, and expand their networks.

Complete the certificate or take just the courses you need to meet your goals.

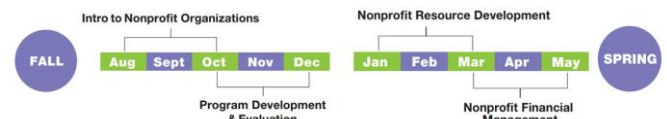

COURSE FORMAT

The program is designed to be completed in a 12-month period, focusing on one course at a time. Evening courses accommodate busy schedules. The four core courses are each 8-weeks long. Each course includes a combination of weekly in-class and online work. A 135-hour culminating internship or project offers students the opportunity to put their learning into practice, while gaining valuable experience. Internships or projects are completed during summer semester.
