Attached is the 2019 COUNTY ROAD NEEDS STUDY SURVEY for gravel and unpaved roads. The Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute (UGPTI) is in the process of updating the 2016 “Assessment of ND County and Local Road Needs” as directed by the 2019 North Dakota Legislature. Unpaved and gravel roads make up about 60% of the cost-to-maintain estimates in the 2016 study. Good survey results are essential to assure that the 2019 study is as accurate as possible.
