"You Show Us" Project Submittals

Entries should be no longer than two pages. Include the following:

1. Agency name, contact person, address, e-mail, phone number
2. Problem statement
3. Discussion of solution
4. Labor, equipment and materials use
5. Project drawing with details
6. Photos
7. A video showing how it works – full operation from start to finish!
8. Cost summary
9. Savings and benefits to agency (monetary and/or safety related)
10. Operating costs: before and after innovation

All entries must be received by July 31, 2019.

The contest is open to the following North Dakota government entities:

- City
- Township
- County

The winner of the North Dakota contest will compete with the winning entries from the states in the LTAP North Central Region. The regional winner will advance to the National competition.
