Self-paced learning is a learning method in which the learner has the control of the amount of material and duration of time they need in order to learn the information properly. It differs from other learning methods because the learner is in control of what they learn and when they learn it.

Self-paced learning modules don't follow a set schedule. They are all about flexibility. All of the course materials are available as soon as the module starts, and the learner goes through them at their own speed.

The **recorded presentations** being shared on the chart are either past video conferences or webinars hosted by the Transportation Learning Network (TLN). Having an account with the TLN learning management system (LMS) allows you to access these recorded sessions free of charge at any time. In the LMS you also have access to printable handouts that were shared during the session. They will serve as a resource for your learning.
