After ten years of dedicated service, Mary Wood-Constable announces that she will step back from the Development Director role at Women Writing for (a) Change, at the end of June. As of July 1st, Mary will continue in a smaller capacity for a period of time, to assist with this transition and other needs of the organization.

Hired as a consultant in 2017, this part-time position marked a formal continuation of the volunteer role Mary filled for the previous five years, alongside her duties as a member of the Board of Trustees.

Mary's introduction to WWf(a)C came in the early 2000's, when her daughter first enrolled in summer camp, and later also attended the 2008 Young Women's Feminist Leadership Academy. Impressed with all she saw, Mary finally took a class herself in 2011—and hasn't stopped since!

Actively involved at WWf(a)C since 2012, Mary began that year as a volunteer on the Development Committee. Several months later, she joined the board. Mary served as president of the board in 2015 and 2016, following two years as vice-president. She continues as a member of multiple committees: Fund Development; Wine, Words & You; Finance; Diversity, Equity and Inclusion; and Strategic Planning.

Women Writing for (a) Change is forever indebted to Mary for her service and leadership. Mary intends to continue with committee work as a volunteer and—always—will sign up for classes.
