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IMPORTANT PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

For hearing on the Oceano Dunes Dust Control Coastal Development Permit (CDP) Amendment Application Number 3-12-050-A3. Please note that there is an upcoming public hearing scheduled for the California Coastal Commission's December 2021 meeting for the following matter pertaining to the California Department of Parks and Recreation's (State Parks') Oceano Dunes park:

- **CDP Amendment Application Number 3-12-050-A3.** Application of California Department of Parks and Recreation to amend CDP No. 3-12-050 (which authorized a five-year program between 2017 and 2022 to reduce dust and particulate matter emissions at State Parks' Oceano Dunes park) to: allow an additional 130 acres of permanent dust control mitigation (i.e., removing these areas from use (where applicable) and restoring/enhancing their dune habitat values) in the dunes (with 108 acres in vehicular access and camping dune areas and 22 acres outside of these areas), which would thus mean that a total of roughly 380 acres of permanent dust control mitigation would be allowed under the CDP as amended (with some 330 acres in vehicular access and camping dune areas and 50 acres outside of these areas). All at State Parks' Oceano Dunes park, which spans the City of Grover Beach and the unincorporated community of Oceano in southern San Luis Obispo County.

The hearing will take place on December 17, 2021. The Coastal Commission will hold a series of hearings this day starting at 9am and will move through each agenda item in order. This matter is on the agenda as item number 12a (CDP Amendment Application Number 3-12-050-A3) on Friday December 17, 2021.
