

Pentecost Script

Either “Recite” or **Do**

“When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place.”

“Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven.”

-have the children make sounds and motions of blowing wind for 10-15 seconds-

“It filled the whole house where they were sitting.”

“They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them.”

-have the children hold tongues of fire over their head, or wave red streamers above their heads for 10-15 seconds-

“All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages as the Spirit led them.”

-have each child say the word Peace from the list below* in the language that is listed by their birthday month-

Sing, say, or shout: “Happy Birthday to God’s church!”

January	Hebrew: שלום (shalom)	July	Swahili: Amani
February	Arabic: سلام (salām)	August	Greek: Eirini:
March	Haitian Creole (Kreyol): Lapè	September	Sweedish: Fred
April	Spanish: Paz	October	Chinese: 和平 (Héping)
May	Hindi: शांति (śānti)	November	Hawaiian: Muluhiā
June	Turkish: Barış	December	Kumeyaay: Taanak (Ta-naak)
