

10 Ways to Pray for Our Church

1. That our congregation would be spiritually strong

Ephesians 3:16 -- I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, **17** so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, **18** may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ.

2. That we would be active in sharing our faith

Philemon 1:6 -- I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ.

3. That we would resist temptation and the devil

1 Peter 5:8 -- Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

4. That we would be a praying people

Ephesians 6:18 -- And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.

5. That God would open new doors to reach more people

Colossians 4:3 -- And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ

6. That God would add to our numbers through salvation to Christ

Acts 2:46-47 -- They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, **47** praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

7. That our worship would be glorious and compelling

Psalms 66:2 Sing the glory of his name; make his praise glorious!

8. That God would continue to bless our church with good leadership

Hebrew 13:17 -- Obey your leaders and submit to their authority. They keep watch over you as men who must give an account. Obey them so that their work will be a joy, not a burden.

9. That God would give us a clear, compelling and supernatural vision

Hab. 2:2 And the LORD answered me: "Write the vision; make it plain on tablets, so he may run who reads it."

10. That God would use us to reach our county

Jonah 4:11 -- (God said to Jonah) "Nineveh has more than a hundred and twenty thousand people who cannot tell their right hand from their left, and many cattle as well. Should I not be concerned about that great city?"
