What do you farm, or what type of farm do you have and approximately how many head?

We are a family farm with a feed to finish operation with a one time capacity of around 300 head (+50 on grass in summer months) and a cow-calf herd consisting of 45 mature cows.

We also grow processing potatoes for McCain Foods and Old Dutch Foods.

Is there anything different or unique at your farm? Do you have any value-added products?

We are a VBP+ certified feedlot and we grow all of our own feed (barley, corn, haylage).

How did you and any partners get into farming, and how long ago did you start?

Our family has been farming here in New Brunswick since 1820. I am the 7th generation. Like a lot of farmers, I grew up in it and realized from a young age that farming was something I was passionate about. I've been farming full time since 2016.

I am passionate about our land, crops and cattle as well as the complimentary nature of raising beef into our potato rotation and the environmental and economic benefits it provides.

Have you incorporated any climate change mitigating practices on your farm? (Rotational grazing, cover crops, etc.)

We use energy free insulated waterers in our feedlot and feed cull potatoes in feedlot to mitigate food waste. We also compost some of our manure to reduce fuel consumption during transport and spreading.

What are you most proud of throughout your farming career?

Being a steward to the land that has helped grow our crops and cattle for Culberson family for over 200 years.

Do you have any future goals for your farm that you would like to share?

Slow steady growth of our feedlot operation with the increasing demand for quality beef here in the Maritimes. To achieve this, I would like to fully integrate cattle grazing into our potato rotation in the future.
