Heavenly Star Search Rules and Regulations

PURPOSE:

- To encourage children to develop their talents and skills and to use them in Christian ministry.
- To help children develop the poise and confidence they need to perform in front of others.
- To help children "attain standards of excellence" as they develop their talent/skills.
- To provide children with helpful suggestions for improving their talents/skills.
- To help children develop competition skills and attitudes as they perform in a caring, Christian atmosphere.
- To affirm every child who participates, regardless of whether he/she wins the top award or not.

FORMAT and RULES:

- To help children develop relationships with children from other churches on the district and to create a spirit of unity.
- Performances will be judged and rated as follows: In each category there will be a first, second and third place trophy awarded to the top three scoring participants.
- In the event of a tie a trophy will be awarded to both participants. Each child may enter up to 3 categories and be a participant of a group category.
- A non-refundable fee of \$15 per child to cover the expense of printing, postage, trophies, and ribbons payable to Central Gulf Coast.
- Completed registration forms sent to the District Children's Ministry Director by February 4, 2022. Any deviation from Nazarene doctrine will be disqualified.
- Contestants should have performed for or will perform for their local church.
- Contestants must be present to win awards.
- Each entry will be judged according to the adjudication sheet. The judge's decision will be final
- All material used in the competition should be memorized. Points will be deducted from contestant's score if material is not memorized.
- All children should be dressed in a clean outfit and well groomed. Appearance and poise count!
- Junior (4th-6th) participants are not allowed to use convenience items in the cooking category. All age groups will receive higher points for recipes that do not use convenience items.

Instrumental Solo

Must be religious song

Five minutes maximum

Two copies of music must be provided for judges

Vocal Solo

Solo only

Must be religious song

Five minutes maximum

Two copies for judges

May use accompaniment tape or piano (NO BACKGROUND VOCALS)

Vocal Duet/Trio/Quartet

Two to four children (ages including pre-k through 6th grade)

Must be religious song

Five minutes maximum

Two copies for judges

May use accompaniment tape or piano (NO BACKGROUND VOCALS)

Vocal Ensemble/Choir

Five children and up (ages including pre-k through 6th grade)

Must be religious song

Five minutes maximum

Two copies for judges, please provide music not just words

May use accompaniment tape or piano (NO BACKGROUND VOCALS)

Drama/Puppetry/Ventriloquism

Drama competition shall be the presentation of a religious published skit, short drama, or cutting from a play

Puppetry – tapes or original voice may be used

For ventriloquism – original voice only

Materials must be memorized

Two copies of material used must be provided for judges

Five minutes maximum

Poem and Bible Memorization

A recitation of a memorized scripture passage, religious poem or prose

Time limit: five (5) minutes

Age appropriateness of selection will be considered

Presentation from religious material

Two copies of materials provided for judges

Writing (Theme: The Goodness of God)

A poem, song, short essay or story written by participant

No more than 2 pages in length and must be typed

Spelling and grammar will count

Age appropriateness on difficulty will be considered

Put in binder or folder

Content must align with the Church of the Nazarene beliefs

3x5 index card with child's name, church, and title of piece

Art (Theme: The Goodness of God)

Use of pencil, crayon, colored pencil, watercolors, paint or markers

Entries must be original

Displays must be matted, mounted, or framed

Sculpture

Must have title for artwork

3x5 index card with child's name, church, and title of piece

Cooking (Theme: Something with Fruit)

Baked product BEFORE coming to competition

Bring all products cooked, wrapped, and displayed nicely

Print 3 copies of the recipes

3x5 index card with child's name, church, and title of piece

All ages will be judged higher if they do not use convenience items. Junior (4th-6th) entries will not be judged if a convenience item is used. (box cake mix, canned icing, etc.)
