This is all about you—a chance to be creative, learn how to tell your stories and help others understand who you are and what it means to have served.

Your experiences are important to share—the good ones and the bad ones, the funny things that happened, and the sadness of being far from home and seeing comrades fall.

In this process, you will be guided by Dave Barton, a writer and theater artist who will meet with you at a time and place of your convenience. After that, you will email your stories to him which he will assist you in editing & polishing.

You will then be invited to read a selection of your stories for an audience of friends, family and interested members of the public on May 11, 2018 at Heroes Hall. Reading your stories at this event is optional. No writing or acting experience is necessary for participation in VOICES.
