

# State Guidelines for Fall

- Current Guidelines will not allow for a in-person restart when we begin in September
- We are bound by metrics established for Clackamas, Multnomah, and Washington Counties
- These guidelines are mandatory, apply to both public and private schools, and Park Academy does not fall under any current exceptions
- Park Academy will operate in 6 week increments to determine our capacity for a transition to in-person education, and if allowed by the state, will make the transition the week of October 19<sup>th</sup>. If not, we will commit to an additional 6 weeks of distance learning. (Each 6 week unit will be preceded by 2 professional development days)

# Part Academy Distance Learning

- School will begin on September 8<sup>th</sup>
  - *The first day will consist of an alternative schedule for student orientation and welcoming*
  - *Regular education classes will commence on Wednesday September 9<sup>th</sup>*
  - *There will be a equipment and supply distribution the week prior, days and times TBD (including Chromebooks, classroom supplies, manipulatives and copied materials*

# Elementary School Distance Learning Format- Key components

- Classes will be held using a combination of Zoom and Google Classroom and all classes will consist of in-person teacher led instruction
- All students will participate in Reading, Language Arts, Mathematics, and Electives Daily. Participation in Science is encouraged but optional to allow for flexibility for students who struggled with on-line learning and experience fatigue over time
- All students in grades 3-5 will have music, theater, and art one day per week. Regular elective choices and scheduling will resume in-person
- Additional clubs, social opportunities, affinity groups etc. are currently under development

# Distance Learning Continued

- School Supplies: For safety and constancy most school supplies will be purchased by the school for distribution to students. Families will be asked to support the cost of the supplies consistent with typical back-to-school supply costs
- Distance Learning Expectations and guidelines will be included in the Family Handbook which will go out next week and will be a part of student orientation meetings.
  - *Standard expectations include online dress code, attendance, camera orientation, learning space and other general practices*
- Standard grading procedures will be maintained for distance and in-person learning
- Gradelink will be utilized for online learning and our new student management system, Alma, will be used for in person instruction
  - *Instructions for registering with Alma will be sent next week. This is where parents will complete the back-to-school registration paperwork and the family handbook.*

# In-Person Education

- We will return to in-person education as soon as we are able and will be evaluating the possibility every 6 weeks. The first possible return will occur on October 21<sup>st</sup>. If necessary we will continue to evaluate and commit to a model in these 6 week increments
- Schedules will be much closer to our standard schedules but school will look very different
  - *Significant COVID safety measures will be in place Including*
    - Mandatory face masks
    - Smaller classes sizes
    - 6 feet distancing
    - Entry and exit protocols including temperature checks
    - Additional cleaning protocols
    - \*Educational material and information will be provided in advance of any transition to in-person learning
    - We are developing synchronous in-person and distance learning options for those who do not feel safe to return or are excluded due to illness and/or exposure

# Limited In-Person Instruction

- Changes to the guidelines made on 8/11/20 will allow for limited in-person instruction
- These allowances can occur in groups of less than 10 students for no more than 2 hours
- This will allow for periodic, targeted opportunities for student support and community building. This is a recent development but may allow for community building, social emotional well-being, targeted instruction and assessment.
- Integration into our program is under development
- Guidelines for safe onsite participation will be given prior to any on site events

# Staffing Changes/Additions

- We are excited to introduce our new Third Grade/Reading Teacher Laura Meeuwsen
  - *17 years of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade experience and training in Oroton Gillingham*
- Chelsea Jepson has moved into a position teaching reading full time
- Sandy Nemer is not returning to focus on her family. We hope to see her again in the future
- Rachel Greenough will be stepping into the reading position
  - *Experienced OG trained tutor and teacher and long time Park Academy Substitute*
- Kim Barton will be retiring at the end of August. She has been one of the faces of Park Academy for over 17 years and will be dearly missed
