Pause to Pray	6 Pray that God would help us to create a prayerful community that leans on Him and relies on prayer to strengthen our spiritual walks.	7 Pray that our teachers and staff would be prayerful in their walks with God, making prayer a priority each day in their personal and professional routines.	8 "Search for the Lord and his strength; continually seek his face." -Psalm 105:4	9 Pray that our world would slow down to embrace time spent with God and a prayerful, surrendered spirit.	10 How can you pause to pray this week? -Wake up 10 min. early to pray -Pray before meals -Pray in the car	11 "Pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert & always keep on praying for all the Lord's people." -Ephesians 6:18	12 Make a habit to pray with your children (and/or for the children in your life) daily. Your habit of prayer will become part of their routine, too.
Look for Christ	13  On Palm Sunday, we remember our need for a Savior. "Hosanna," which they shouted as Jesus entered Jerusalem, means "Save us!"	14 Pray that our school would be a place that the community sees God at work and experiences the love of Christ.	15 "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." -John 10:10	16 Pray that our world would look to the Savior, who died for every one of us to experience life to the fullest in Him.	17 As you experience Christ in your daily life, how can you allow His goodness to spill over into the lives of those around you?	18 "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." -Mark 10:45	19 Share the radical message of Jesus coming to serve with your children/grandchildren/students & ask them how <u>they</u> can serve someone.
