What do you know about Days for Girls? This is a program that our mission partner in Zambia, Melissa Johnson, brought to our attention. Several of our members loved the idea of taking care of our sisters-in-need in Zambia and pulled out their sewing machines. Though we haven't had the opportunity to have sewing parties at FPCB lately, we are still shipping items that are lovingly made by a group of women who joined in this mission. Each shipment contains 120 kits and supplies for the Days for Girls Enterprise Team in Lundazi (established by Melissa Johnson). The approximate cost for 120 kits is \$1800. Mostly supplies have been purchased by the women who have created the kits. Since December 2018, 710 kits have been sent to the CCAP Health Department in Lundazi by FPCB members and friends supporting this mission. Financial help from Presbyterian Women and Partners in Mission is much appreciated. More good news! Melissa Johnson will be returning to Zambia sometime this month. Charles, her husband, who has retired from being a mission partner, will travel with her but will not stay. Please keep Melissa and Days for Girls in your prayers.
