



**CHURCH SAFETY AND SECURITY:** Over the past few months, there has been a growing concern among the staff and Session about the security of the church on Sunday mornings. There have been several incidents more recently, including a theft at another downtown church, that have brought this issue more to the forefront.

On recommendation from the staff, the Session has authorized the locking of all doors (except for the sanctuary doors) on Sunday morning. As you make your way into the church building, please go to one of the doors with a buzzer and you will be let in.

In addition, during the worship hour, there will be an elder who will be walking throughout the building to make sure that there is no one in the building that shouldn't be there.

We realize that this may be an inconvenience to some, and we apologize for that. But the safety of all our members, especially our children, takes precedence.
