

## A Good Restart

We had a good restart to in-person worship last Sunday. It was wonderful to see people in our Sanctuary again! There was much uncertainty going into the morning, but God's spirit prevailed and we had two excellent worship services. The total attendance at the two services was 135 – a surprisingly strong number. I appreciate the way those who attended complied with the rules of social distancing and moved so smoothly into a new way of doing things.

We are watching very closely the trends in the spread of the coronavirus. As we have said from day one, this is a very fluid situation and we will make changes as needed. Our current plan is to continue with in-person worship, but we have made a few revisions to our guidelines to help ensure everyone's safety and well-being.

The wearing of a mask is not mandatory, but with the uptick of COVID-19 cases, it is preferred. You will be required to wear a mask as you enter and exit the Sanctuary. Masks are preferred but not required while sitting in the pews. Thank you for your cooperation.

Singing has been identified as a high risk means of transmitting the virus even if masks are worn. There will continue to be no-singing in our 9:00 service. If you are particularly susceptible to catching the virus this is the service for you to attend. We will continue to sing, though very little, during the 11:00 service.

Finally, and this is something you will very seldom if ever hear a pastor say – if you are the slightest bit uncomfortable about attending worship then please stay home. We have done and will continue to do our best to make our worship environment as safe as possible. Still, the safest means of joining us in worship is to live-stream our 11:00 service or watch it later on Facebook, YouTube, or on the website. The demographic of our congregation makes us a potentially more vulnerable group. While I would love to see you in worship, I strongly encourage you to make good choices as you consider your attendance.

Thank you for your patience and your prayers as we continue this journey into the unknown. Stay strong in your faith and for each other. Always remember that God is with us. We are not alone. Thanks be to God! Amen!




