

The Society of American Military Engineers offers a unique series of engineering and construction camps/programs that are designed for high school students who excel in science, technology and math and are interested in pursuing engineering, architecture or STEM-related fields in college. These camps are high energy, hands-on events for students from across the country and around the world. The camps are led by a professional staff of engineers from the military services and private industry. Each camp is approximately one week in duration and each has its own unique focus and theme. The

Engineering & Construction camps are a one-of-a-kind opportunity to experience what engineers, architects and builders do, to learn practical skills, and to gain exposure to the military services.

For 2021, the Seattle Post will sponsor three students – one each to attend either the **U.S. Marine Corps Camp**, the **U.S. Navy Camp**, the **U.S. Air Force Camps**, or the **U.S. Coast Guard Academy's AIM Program**. Dates and locations of these programs are noted below.

SAME/U.S. Marine Corps Engineering and Construction Camp - Dates: June 20, 2021 through June 26, 2021

Location: Camp Lejeune -- Jacksonville, North Carolina

SAME/U.S. Navy STEM Engineering and Construction Camp – (Virtual) -- Dates: June 20, 2021 through June 26, 2021; **Location:** -- Port Hueneme, California

SAME/U.S. Air Force Engineering and Construction Camp - Dates: June 25, 2021 through July 2, 2021; **Location:** -- U.S. Air Force Academy, Colorado Springs, Colorado

SAME/Air Force Engineering and Construction Camp - Dates: July 26, 2021 through July 31, 2021; **Location:** -- Scott Air Force Base, Illinois

U.S. Coast Guard Academy Introduction Mission (AIM) Program - Dates: Session I -- July 4, 2021 through July-9, 2021, Session II -- July 11, 2021 through July 16, 2021, and Session III – July 18, 2021 through July 23, 2021; **Location:** -- U.S. Coast Guard Academy, New London, Connecticut

Applications for the Marine, Navy and Air Force camps must be submitted through the SAME National web portal no later than March 15, 2021. SAME National will notify the Seattle Post of applications that identify the Seattle Post as a possible sponsor. The Seattle Post will make its final student selections by **March 24, 2021** and will notify SAME National and prospective applicants. Applications for the **U.S. Coast Guard Academy's AIM Program** are due by April 1, 2021. Prospective candidates submit the application on the website directly to the Coast Guard Academy AIM program. The U.S. Coast Guard Academy will notify students that are selected by April 30, 2021.

The evaluation process of prospective applicants for these programs by the Seattle Post will be on the basis of the application materials that are provided. The Seattle Post will pay the full registration fee and travel costs associated with each successful applicant that is sponsored by the Seattle Post.
