

## **Huffy Corporation moving to Miami Township**

Company needs more space for operations

The Huffy Corporation announced plans in mid-September to move its operations to Miami Township. It will occupy a 50,000-square foot facility at 8877 Gander Creek Dr. by the end of the year. Huffy President and Chief Executive Officer Bill Smith says

the move is needed for future growth of the company. He says the new facility is 40-percent larger than its current location in Centerville.

"The Miami Township building is ideal for our home operations which allows us more room and better facilities for our new business initiatives and planned growth," Smith said. "We can expand and stretch the footprint of marketing, sales and operations to meet our growing needs. All of our product



innovations and creative designs happen right here in Dayton, Ohio, and the new space gives us more flexibility for our customer meetings."

The new facility will be designed to better facilitate product and strategy sessions with market retailers and licensors such as Walmart, Target, Toys 'R' Us, and Disney. Those companies work closely with Huffy to strategize new products. A new fitness center will also be available to employees.

Huffy is celebrating its 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary in the bicycle business. Its first bicycle was built in 1892 in Dayton. The brand is sold at more than 10,000 retail locations around the United States and in more than 50 countries worldwide. Huffy manufactures bicycles, trikes, scooters, and ride-ons for all ages.
