1. **SpNS: Special Needs Shelter** – Assists evacuees with disabilities or functional medical needs. This is a **Pet Friendly shelter for special needs persons only**. Evacuees and their service animals will remain in the same location.
2. **PF:Pet Friendly** – people and pets are housed in separate locations at the shelter
3. **PPS: People & Pet Shelter** (people and pets are housed in the same location – **Fairgrounds only**)

“Residents should never go to a public shelter unless local officials have announced it is open. Public shelters are only opened as needed and based on the situation/threat. During a disaster or storm, not all of the public shelters may open.”
