Open House Information:

As our Oviatt students are all new to the building in 2020-21, our staff believes it is important to welcome students and parent(s)/guardian(s) to an in-person open house experience. **Oviatt's K-1st Open House is scheduled for Thursday, August 20th from 10am-6pm.** Students and parent(s)/guardian(s) will be able to visit the building, their classroom, grab a snack in the cafeteria, visit the bus rodeo, and check out our new outdoor playgrounds. As a part of our <u>Oviatt Return to Learn Plan</u>, we are putting the following health and safety modifications in place to ensure we create a safe environment:

• Families will sign up with an appointment using conferencing software (20 min. time spots)

- This will be available the week after classroom assignments go live (Aug. 14th).
- Check in at Kindergarten (east side, door #1) & 1st Grade entrances (west side, main door).
- Only parent(s)/guardian(s) in attendance with student siblings/friends/other family members may not attend.
- Follow physical distancing recommendations in shared spaces both indoors and outdoors.
- Face coverings (nose & mouth) are required when social distancing is not able to be maintained.
- 1 student + parent(s)/guardian(s) in the classroom at a time.

Oviatt will host a separate Open House for our Universal Preschool students on Tuesday, September 1st from 4:00-7:00pm.

Classroom Assignments:

The following language regarding classroom assignments exists in our student handbook, as well as board policy. Class assignments will be available through Infinite Campus Parent Portal beginning August 14th.

Posting of Class Lists (NCSD Elementary Handbook)

Due to safety concerns for our students, we do not post class lists on the entry of the school building. This will help us assure that the child's parent/guardian is the only person to know the child's teacher and classroom placement within the building. Parents will be able to get classroom placement through their Parent Portal account or by calling the school in mid-August.

Student Placement (NCSD Board Policy)

All regular students enrolled in grade first through 5th grade shall be placed in classes heterogeneously by random assignment with gender and cultural equity. Parents are not allowed to request a certain teacher for their child, however, a parent with a child immediately following another sibling who is placed with the same teacher, may request a change. This request must be in writing and submitted to the principal by the third Friday of May.
