The Medical Arts Hospital (MAH) is seeking an experienced hospital leader for the position of Chief Financial Officer (CFO) to serve their facility. Medical Arts Hospital, located in Lamesa, Texas, is the “hub” of healthcare to more than 83,000 residents in Dawson County and the surrounding areas. MAH, a hospital district (Dawson County Hospital District), is a rural community-owned and operated hospital providing a wide range of patient-focused care with a commitment to patient satisfaction. MAH opened a new facility in 2009 with 70,000 sq. ft. which provides an increased focus on the day-to-day healthcare of residents.

As a 21 bed facility, MAH provides Acute Care, Swing Bed and the MAH Emergency Room is a Certified Level IV Trauma facility by the Texas Department of State Health Services. The Outpatient and Emergency services were built to accommodate current needs as well as needs for the future of a growing community. The closest tertiary facilities are 60 miles away; making MAH a life-saving and necessary component in the service area. Also, provided is Lab, Cardiopulmonary, Imaging, General Radiology X-Ray, Echo/Vascular Ultrasound, CT, MRI, Ultrasound, Nuclear Medicine, Bone Densitometry, and Physical Therapy, as well as, the Medical Arts Rural Health Clinic and Medical Arts Specialty Annex.

The successful candidate for the Hospital CFO position will have a minimum of three to five (3-5) years of acute care hospital finance experience in leadership positions, along with exemplary communication, presentation and interpersonal skills, plus a demonstrable dedication to customer service in an economically diverse community. They should possess a minimum of a Bachelor’s degree in business, accounting or finance; a Master’s degree and CPA certification is preferred but not required. Rural healthcare and hospital district experience is preferred.

Candidate must be a strong, hands-on and approachable leader who understands the value of being a team player. Must understand how to motivate and inspire staff to achieve optimal results and must be ready to assist CEO in positioning the hospital for the future.

Lamesa is a city in and the county seat of Dawson County TX. Lamesa is located in the center of Dawson County. US Highway 87 (Lynn Avenue) passes through the eastern side of the city, leading north 60 miles to Lubbock and southeast 40 miles to Big Spring. US Highway 180 passes through the center of town as 4<sup>th</sup> Street and leads west 40 miles to Seminole and east 60 miles to Snyder. Texas State Highway 137 passes through the city as Bryan Avenue.
