Stephens Memorial Hospital (SMH) in Breckenridge, Texas is seeking an experienced hospital leader for the position of Chief Executive Officer (CEO) to serve their facility. The candidate should exhibit high moral integrity, superior communication skills, strong financial management and innovative leadership skills. Primary responsibilities of the CEO will be to provide direction and administration of all aspects of hospital district activities to assure quality patient care and regulatory compliance.

SMH is a comprehensive healthcare system that services Stephens County. It is comprised of Stephens Memorial Hospital and Breckenridge Medical Center. A 40-bed licensed hospital, SMH provides general medical and surgical care for inpatient, outpatient and has a 24-hour per day, seven-day per week emergency room that is designated as a Level IV trauma center. The hospital provides acute care admission, outpatient surgery, cardiology, outpatient physical therapy, cardiac rehab, laboratory, nuclear medicine, routine radiology, CT, MRI, & Ultrasound, skilled nursing care as well as respiratory care and modern state-of-the-art equipment to help diagnose and treat medical needs.

The successful candidate should possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree (master's degree in healthcare related field preferred) and a minimum of ten (10) years as a senior level hospital executive with five (5) of those years as a CEO of an acute care hospital with demonstrated successful leadership. Rural hospital and hospital district experience are a plus. This candidate must exhibit the ability to interact with physicians, hospital staff, and the community as well as have a strong understanding of strategic management, team building, quality improvement, problem solving, and decision making.

Breckenridge, located in Stephens County (population 9,500), is a progressive community with a great quality of life as well as extensive educational and business opportunities. Breckenridge is surrounded by three area lakes and has superb hunting available. Situated at the crossroads of U.S. Highways 180 and 183, it is approximately 100 miles west of Fort Worth, 59 miles south of Wichita Falls, 150 miles north west of Waco and 58 miles north east of Abilene. Breckenridge has an airport with a 5000-foot runway and an Automated Weather Observation System. Breckenridge has an excellent school system and a local Texas State Technical College. There are two Junior Colleges within 30 miles and three higher education colleges within 55 miles of Breckenridge.
