
With Tech hosts online & in the classroom, to run the technical side of things, so leaders can concentrate on their programs.



What's new with Program Registration for Leaders



- **We now have Three different types of registration lists based on format**
In-person and Online (Zoom) - each has its own enrolled, max and waitlist numbers
- **RO** – Recorded Only - is new this semester. There is no waitlist for this option. This option is designed for members who want to attend multiple classes at the same time.
- **Waitlist is now sorted by date/time of registration, rather than alphabetically**
easier to add to enrolled based on first come, first serve


Remember: Leaders can only change the status of enrollees

SacLink accounts for Zoom & Classroom Tech




- All leaders using Zoom should have an account for this semester
- We manage the Ren-XX accounts only, not other CSUS accounts (e.g. Not jane.smith@csus.edu)
- Contact us if you need an account for in-person to use classroom equipment
- Don't change your password
- University's security policy requires passwords be changed every 365 days
- We change the passwords for the Zoom accounts at the beginning of summer



Instructions


- Connect to the **SacLink** wireless network.
- Open your preferred internet browser. It should automatically redirect to the Wireless Network Login Page. If it does not, navigate to <https://wireless.webhost.csus.edu>.
- On the landing page, click on **SacLink Guest Login**.
- Type in an email address and select **Log In** and you will be connected to the SacLink network.

- Connect to the **SacLink** wireless network



- Open a web browser and click **Sac State Guest Login**



Note: After 4 hours, you will be prompted to enter your e-mail address again.


Eduroam Wireless Access



Start Here: Instructions to connect to Eduroam

- In your device's Wi-Fi menu connect to SacLink.
- Open a web browser, and you should be redirected to the Sacramento State Wireless Network page (<https://wireless.webhost.csus.edu/>).
- If the Sacramento State Wireless Network page does not load, try manually going to the following web page, which should force the redirect: myip.csus.edu
- Click on Connect to eduroam.
- The operating system for your device will be detected automatically.
- Follow the instructions for your device and click JoinNow.
- When prompted, enter your *SacLink username* and *password*.


