***The way we approach our finances is an excellent indicator of how we approach our faith.***

- God doesn’t judge us based on how MUCH money we have
  - He judges us based on our MOTIVATION for getting it
  - He judges us based on our METHODS of getting it
  - He judges us based on our MANAGEMENT of it when we get it
