FROM MY HEART TO YOURS

Dear Church Family,

When you think of Sunday School (now known as Connect Groups) what comes to mind? Is it simply a Sunday Morning time slot, or a place you go to learn about Jesus? My prayer is that it is so much more than either of those. Our desire at FBC Moultrie is for our groups (classes) to become part of your daily lives. We want to see Connect Group members growing in their faith through a deeper connection to God, one another, and our mission: to make disciples (followers of Christ) in Moultrie, GA and around the world. There are 5 connections that we are challenging each Connect Group member to make a deeper commitment to in the coming year:

1. Connection #1: God's Word – As disciples of Christ, we must be devoted to daily scripture reading. (Hebrews 4:12, Romans 1:16, Romans 12:2)
2. Connection #2: Prayer – As disciples of Christ, we must be in daily prayer for our lost acquaintances, our brothers and sisters in Christ, and ourselves. (Matthew 26:41, Ephesians 6:18, James 5:16, Romans 12:2,12)
3. Connection #3: Members – As disciples of Christ, we must sacrificially love and connect with our brothers and sisters in Christ beyond Sunday mornings, in daily life. (Acts 2:42, John 13:34, 1 John 1:7, Philemon 1:6, Romans 12:3-13, Hebrews 10:24-25)
4. Connection #4: Visitors – As disciples of Christ, we must welcome all who come into our Connect Groups with the love of Christ. (1 Corinthians 10:24, Romans 14:1)
5. Connection #5: The World on Mission – As disciples of Christ, we are responsible for sharing the Good News in our community and beyond. (Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 1:8, Romans 10:14-15)

In the coming weeks and months, we will be providing opportunities for you to make deeper commitments in each of these areas. Some of those will be offered through your Connect Groups and others will be offered church wide. We pray that you will make a commitment to join with us as we seek to grow in our faith through a deeper connection to God, one another, and our mission. We specifically pray that each member becomes regularly involved in a Connect Group.
