## **“Shelter in Peace”**

James 1:12

### **Today’s BIG IDEA:**

***The resurrection of Jesus enables us to have peace in the midst of our trials.***

### **1. We can be sheltered in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.12a)**

- The Greek word for “blessed” is the word “**makarios**”
  - o It means “happy; blessed; the recipient of favor”

### **2. We can be sheltered in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.12b)**

- The Greek word for “stood the test” is the word “**dokimos**”
  - o It means “to be tried and found genuine; to be proven; verified”

### **3. We must be sheltered in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.12c)** *(John 3:16)*

2. What excites you most about your relationship with Jesus? What gives you happiness and hope as you walk with him?
