

W.W.J.D.

When I was in middle school, people wore three things if they wanted to be cool—Timberland boots, a shirt from Gap or Old Navy, and a W.W.J.D. bracelet. Those W.W.J.D. bracelets came in all kinds of colors and were the go-to fashion accessory of my early teen years. The letters on the bracelet stood for “What Would Jesus Do,” and the idea was that as you wore the bracelet, it would remind you to live your life like Jesus would. The only problem was that most people didn’t really want to live like Jesus. They just wore the bracelet to fit in.

You may or may not have a W.W.J.D. bracelet, but we are all called to live our lives like Jesus would. That’s why, over the next few weeks, we’ll be studying this topic together in a sermon series called “In His Steps.” We’re going to look at the pivotal moments in Jesus’ ministry when he set an example for us to follow.

Unfortunately, there are a lot of us who really aren’t interested in following in Jesus’ steps. We just want enough of him to help us blend in.

But what would it look like if you and I really took the call of discipleship seriously? What would it look like if we sought to follow Jesus’ example in everything we did? What if we worshiped like him? Prayed like him? Ministered like him? Sacrificed like him? The world would never be the same.

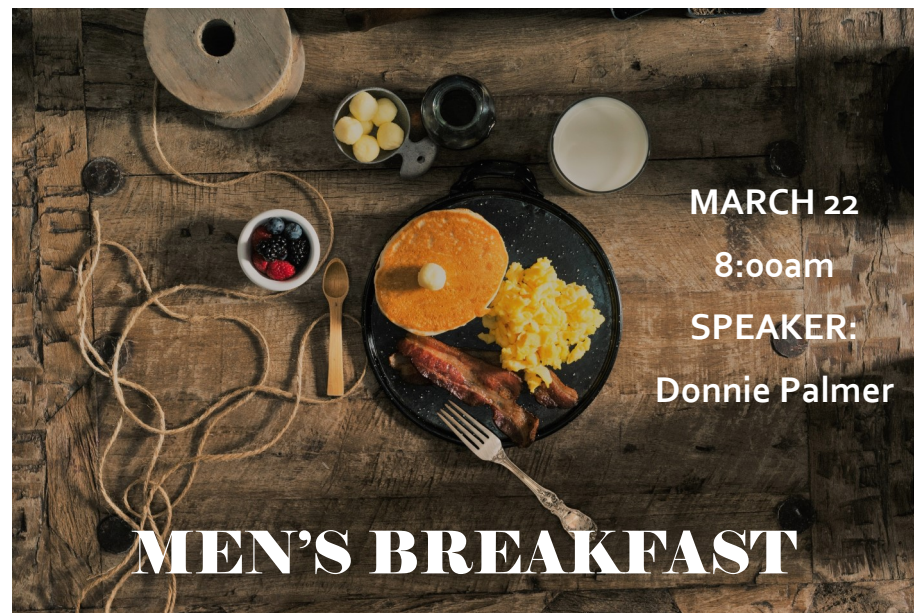
