Children develop tremendously between **18 and 36 months**. The foundation provided by a toddler program supports future learning with ample and appropriate sensory, social, and language development experiences.

Learner Led, Teacher Supported

Parker's rich and diverse outdoor environment sets the stage for wonder and curiosity. Our teachers let students follow their imaginations and give them freedom to explore. Our mixed-age groups give the children –and their parents – a chance to learn from each other.

There is an intrinsic relationship between children and nature. Children who spend time outside develop confidence, agility, balance, spatial awareness, as well as the social and emotional skills of kindness and empathy. Being outside supports skills necessary for later learning.
