

Where should I go to get a COVID-19 Test?

Go to a community-based testing site in **Illinois** and **Wisconsin** if you are:

- **not** experiencing symptoms
- **not** seeking treatment by a clinician
- simply seeking a COVID-19 test



Patients with symptoms who are seen in their doctor's office, at an urgent care site, or by video visit may continue to be tested in the office or at an urgent or immediate care center.

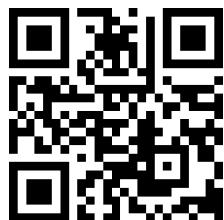
Why should I go to a community-based testing site?
