Community Testing Sites



Advocate Aurora Health is now offering expanded COVID-19 testing for community members who have COVID-19 symptoms or who believe they have been exposed to COVID-19 in their household or through significant exposure at work or in public.

COVID symptoms include: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, body or muscle aches, headache, fatigue, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or recent loss of taste or smell.
