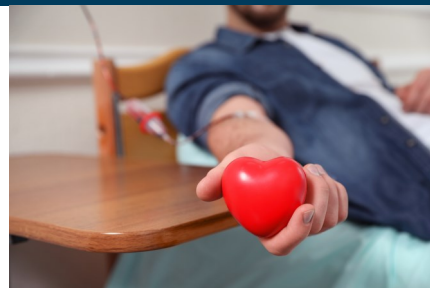


Advocate Aurora Health Blood Drives in January 2021
