Refuge for Women is a national network of restorative aftercare homes offering a new beginning for women who have been trafficked and exploited. Karen was part of the team that launched a home in McHenry County for survivors and has worked with staff to implement the trauma-informed, evidence-based, three-phase programming model that has served more than 25 women to date since the home's opening in 2016.



Suzanne Martinez, coordinator for congregational outreach for the Office for Mission and Spiritual Care for Advocate Good Shepherd Hospital, Advocate Condell Medical Center and Advocate Sherman Hospital, will facilitate the webinars. Suzanne's role includes supporting area faith communities with health and wellness education seminars and developing new programs and activities that strengthen partnerships between Advocate Aurora Health and congregations.
