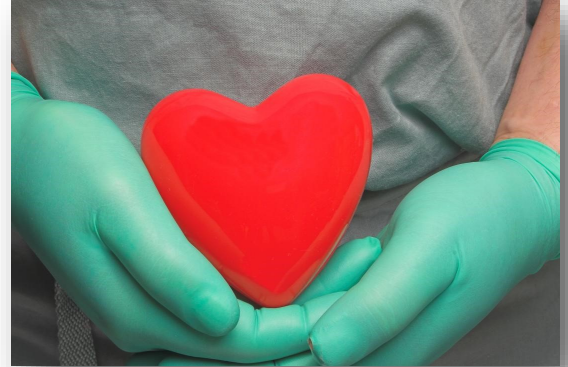


Register today for *Live from the Heart*
